During the Regular Meeting of the Freeport Area School District Board of School Directors held on Wednesday, **March 13, 2019**, the following agenda items were **approved**:

Personnel

The resignation of Linda Yurchick Kuruc, Teacher, effective June 3, 2019.

The resignation of Cynthia L. Weltner, 12 Month Secretary, effective July 31, 2019.

A Memorandum of Agreement with the Freeport Education Association providing for modification to the District's list of extracurricular positions effective with the 2019-2020 school year.

The employment of Jay T. Powell as Volunteer Softball Coach, Tahlon N. Kirkland as Volunteer Head Girls Lacrosse Coach, and Cassie L. Suran as Volunteer Girls Lacrosse Coach for the 2018-2019 school year, effective March 13, 2019.

A list of positions for the District's Athletics Programs for the 2019-2020 school year, with salaries in accordance with contracted terms of remuneration approved by the Board.

A list of substitute personnel for the 2018-2019 school year.

Curriculum and Technology

Athletics and Activities
