All Schools	8:00 AM - 11:00 AM

Conferences at the **Elementary and Middle School** level (Grades K-8) will be **by appointment only**. Please look for specific scheduling information to be sent home with your child in the coming weeks.

Conferences at the **High School** level (Grades 9-12) do not require an appointment. There will be a sign-up sheet posted at each teacher's classroom during conference hours. You may visit the school office if you need a schedule, a building map, or if you have any questions.

It is important for you to understand that to accommodate all interested parents it will be necessary for the staff to maintain a strict schedule. Therefore, we are requesting that students and/or children not accompany their parents and that parents limit their time to fifteen (15) minutes per teacher. In some instances, a lengthier discussion may be necessary to review your child's progress. If so, please feel free to schedule another appointment at a later date with the teacher through the school office.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, some staff members may not be available during evening conferences. Therefore, please call your school to verify an individual teacher's conference hours.

It is our intent to have a collaborative effort between parents and teachers in the development of your child's education. We would like to see as many parents as possible attend these conferences.
