#### WEEKLY BLOGGING ASSIGNMENT:

1 – FIND and READ a “current events” news article. The article should be online so that the class can follow a hyperlink and read it themselves. It should be an article from a legitimate news source or journal (ask if you are unsure about this)

2 – POST a summary and review of the news story. Answer the following questions as you do:

A – Who? What? When? Where? and Why?

B – What bias or point-of-view does the author expose?

C – Explain your point-of-view on the issue or event. What should be done? Why is it important?

D – Check back for type-o’s and *be sure your post is between 10-15 sentences in length.*

3 – INCLUDE a related image and hyperlink to the article

④ – LINK your post to the appropriate **category** before clicking on Publish!

5 – BE READY to discuss this article in class.
