

## Independent Film Study

### *How it works.*

You will be in charge of the daily editing of the Morning Announcements and Programming our District cable station. The edit schedule will depend on the number of students in the class. In addition, you will be responsible for producing and editing a minimum of five special productions (see below).

**This class requires independent out-of-school filming. Students are responsible for the equipment they take from school. Never leave equipment in a car over night.**

### *Productions for the Year*

Morning Announcements (Daily)  
Best of Skits (due before Christmas Break)  
Taping of School Production (Throughout the Year)  
Unbuzzed (Late Winter/Early Spring)  
Class of DVD (Early Spring)

### *Deadlines.*

Due to equipment limitations, each producer will have his or her own deadline for each documentary.

### *Editing.*

In addition to class time, students must make time to edit before, during or after school. It is the only way to meet your deadline.

### *One Evening Production.*

**During one of your four nine-week periods, you must participate in one evening production.** Since many students participate in sports and other activities, make sure you schedule your production work during the off-season. Don't wait until the night of Graduation and say you have to work. These productions include plays, musicals, concerts, sporting events, Bee-TV Specials and more. This assignment will be worth 30 points, which will be added to the grading period in which the production occurs.

### *Your work on Television and the Web*
