*During the Regular Meeting of the Freeport Area School District Board of School Directors held on Wednesday, **January 17, 2018**, the following agenda items were approved:*

Personnel

A schedule of early-bird and mentor teacher and substitute personnel compensation rates for the 2018-2019 school year.

The employment of Robert F. Woods, Jr., as a Volunteer Varsity Football Coach during the 2017-2018 school year.

Curriculum and Technology

A Dual Enrollment Agreement with Indiana University of Pennsylvania, to permit participation of District students in the University's dual enrollment program during the 2017-2018 through 2022-2023 school years.
