## **Post-Thanksgiving Break**

### Buffalo and South Buffalo Elementary Schools

- Full Remote Instruction on December 1st, 2nd, and 3rd
- Return to their normal face-to-face instruction schedule on December 7th

### Middle and High Schools

- Full Remote Instruction on December 1st, 2nd, and 3rd
- Hybrid-A/B Days schedule on December 7th, 8th and 9th, 10th
- Return to their normal face-to-face instruction schedule on December 14th

## **Post-Christmas/New Year's Break**

### Buffalo and South Buffalo Elementary Schools

- Full Remote Instruction on January 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th
- Return to their normal face-to-face instruction schedule on January 11th

### Middle and High Schools

- Full Remote Instruction on 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th
- Hybrid-A/B Days schedule on January 11th, 12th and 13th, 14th
- Return to their normal face-to-face instruction schedule on January 19th

Be assured of follow-up communications and reminders from the respective buildings to assist students and families through these transitions.
