It was moved by Mr. Haven, and seconded by Mr. Selinger,

- c. To approve the employment of Thomas W. Shotts as a full time Custodian, at an hourly wage rate of \$15.50, effective October 7, 2022.
- d. To approve the employment of Erica L. Walter as a part-time Cafeteria Worker, at an hourly wage rate of \$12.75, effective October 7, 2022 and contingent on satisfactory completion of all pre-employment requirements.

- c. To accept the attached proposal of Tobey Karg Service Agency, Inc., for preventive maintenance services to be provided during the 2022-2023 school year on the Freeport Area Middle School chiller, at a cost of \$2,070.
- d. To accept the attached proposal of Tobey Karg Service Agency, Inc., for preventive maintenance services to be provided during the 2022-2023 school year on the Freeport Area High School, Buffalo Elementary School, and South Buffalo Elementary School chillers and cooling units, at a cost of \$7,275.
